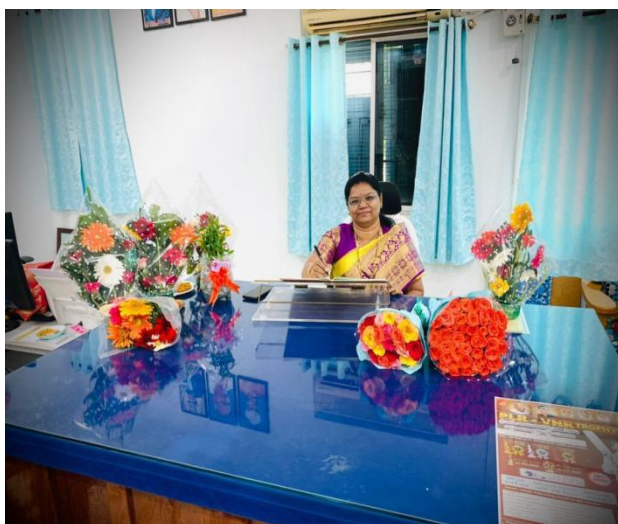

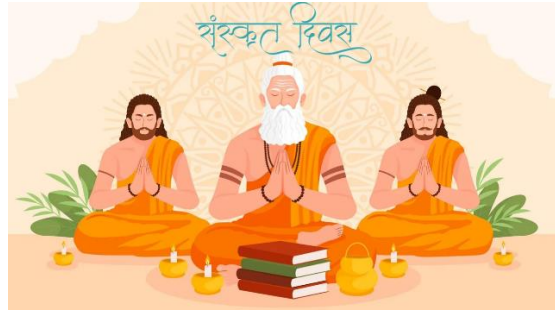
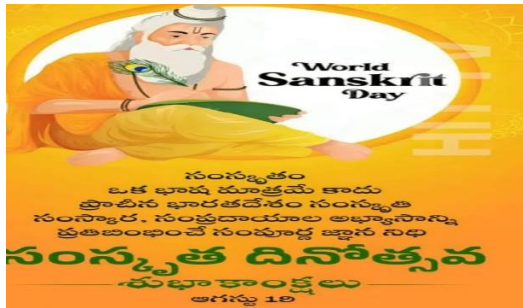




# World Sanskrit Day 2024

2. To motivate the young student minds towards evolution of Indian space research.
3. To understand the youth students about our ISRO and it's other organizations.

#### Importance :

The students of Physics and Electronics, of PVKN Govt. College(A), Chittoor, celebrated its first-ever National Space Day on August 23, 2024, marking the one-year

anniversary of the Chandrayaan-3 mission's historic landing on the Moon. The day was declared to honour this achievement, where India became the first country to land near the Moon's south pole and the fourth country to land on the Moon overall.

The celebrations were highlighted by a series of events and initiatives aimed at inspiring the next generation and showcasing India's growing capabilities in space exploration. The theme for this inaugural celebration was "Touching Lives while Touching the Moon: India's Space Saga," emphasizing how space exploration benefits not only scientific advancement but also the everyday lives of people.

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is India's space agency, which is part of the Department of Space (DOS) of the Government of India. ISRO has its headquarters in Bengaluru. Its activities are spread across various centres and units.

- 1) Launch Vehicles are built at Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC), Thiruvananthapuram;
- 2) Satellites are designed and developed at U R Rao Satellite Centre (URSC), Bengalure.
- 3) Integration and launching of satellites and launch vehicles are carried out from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC), Sriharikota.
- 4) Development of liquid stages including cryogenic stage is carried out at Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre (LPSC), Valiamala & Bengaluru.
- 5) Sensors for Communication and Remote Sensing satellites and application aspects of the space technology are taken up at Space Applications Centre (SAC), Ahmedabad and
- 6) Remote Sensing satellite data reception processing and dissemination is entrusted to National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), Hyderabad.

### Out Comes:

The 26th number of students are attended the National Space Day-day also served as a platform to encourage youth students to pursue careers in STEM fields and contribute to India's growing space sector.
