**Objective of Activity:** To Give Awareness on Learning Resources

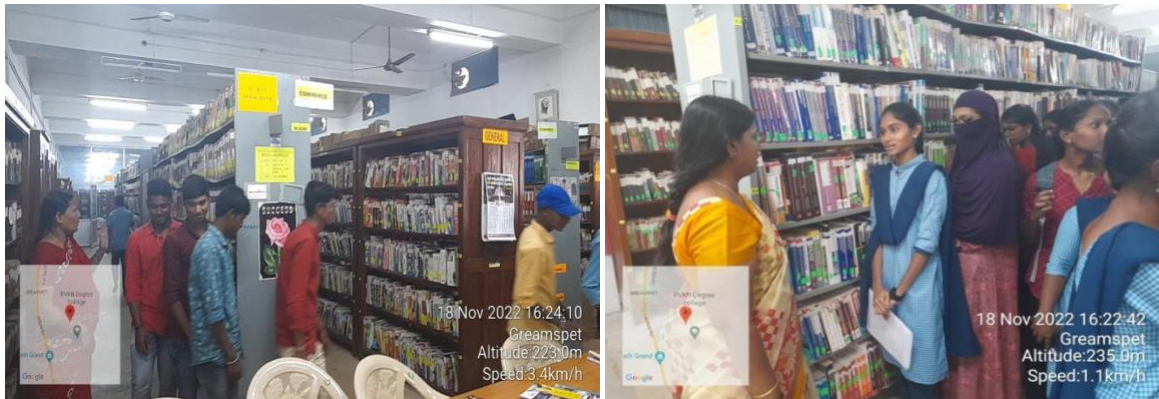

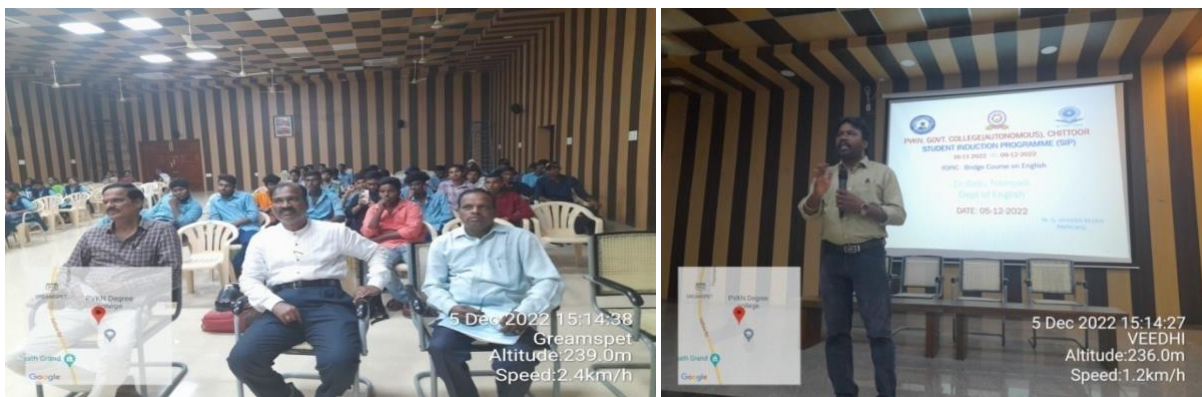

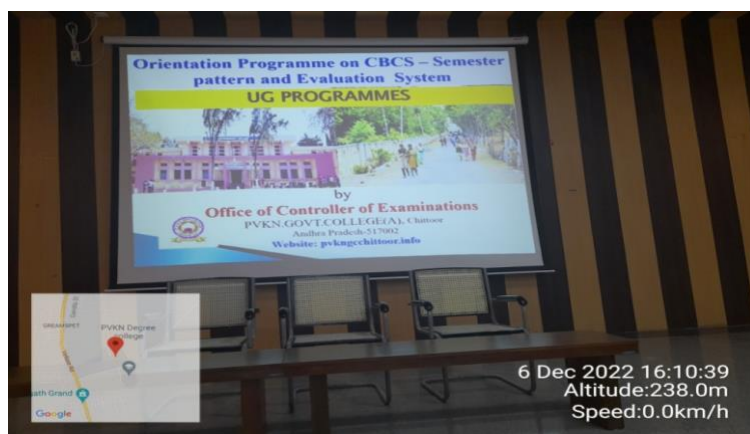

#### **10. Getting Laptop and Mobile Phones from the Govt of AP on the Occasion of World Disabled Day on 03-12-2022**





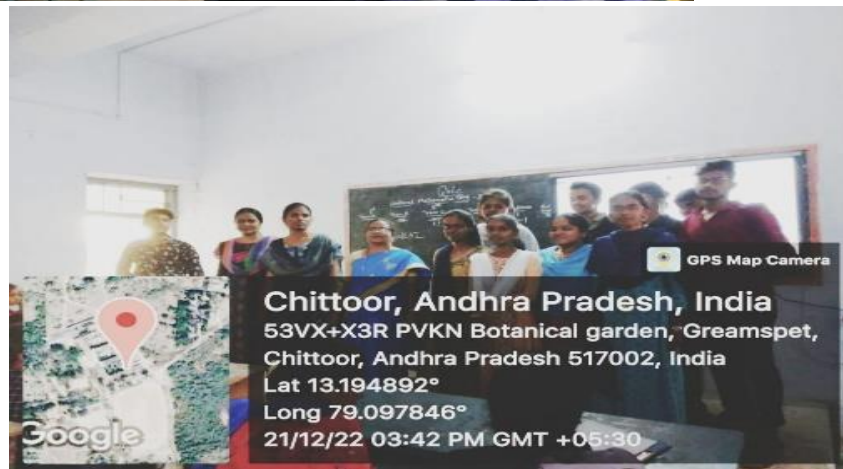

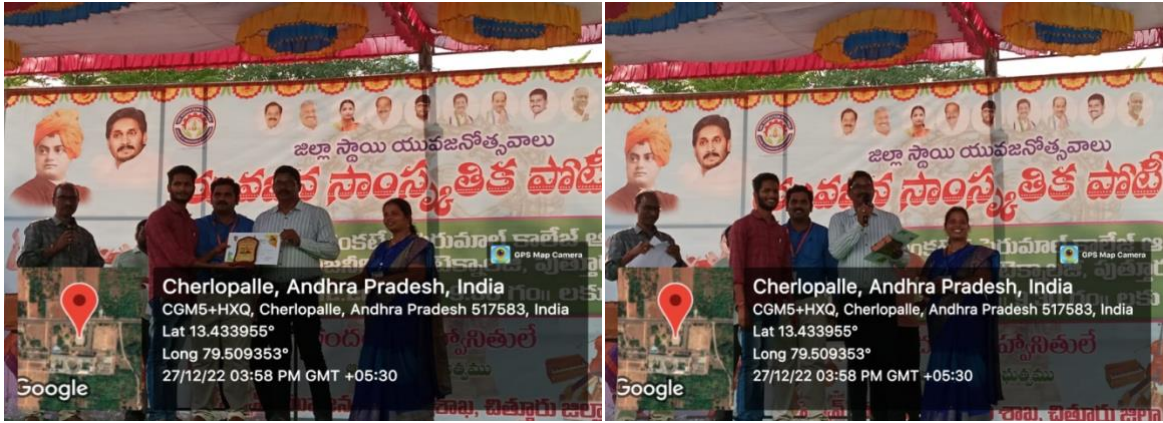

### 23. CULTURAL ACTIVITIS : YOUTH FESTIVAL

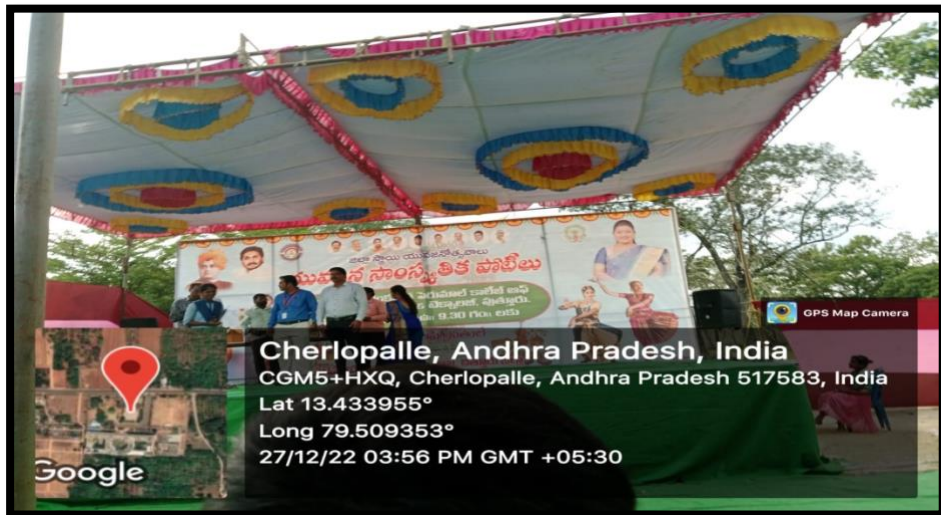
