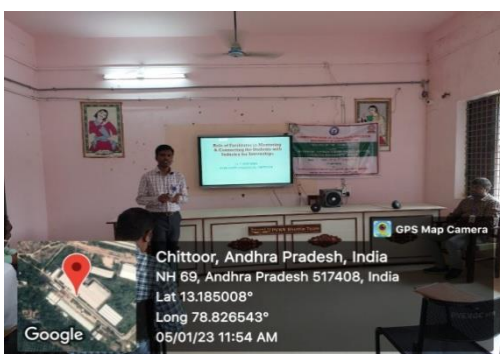

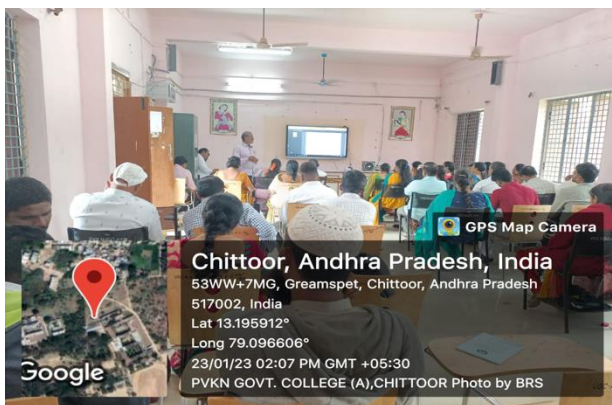

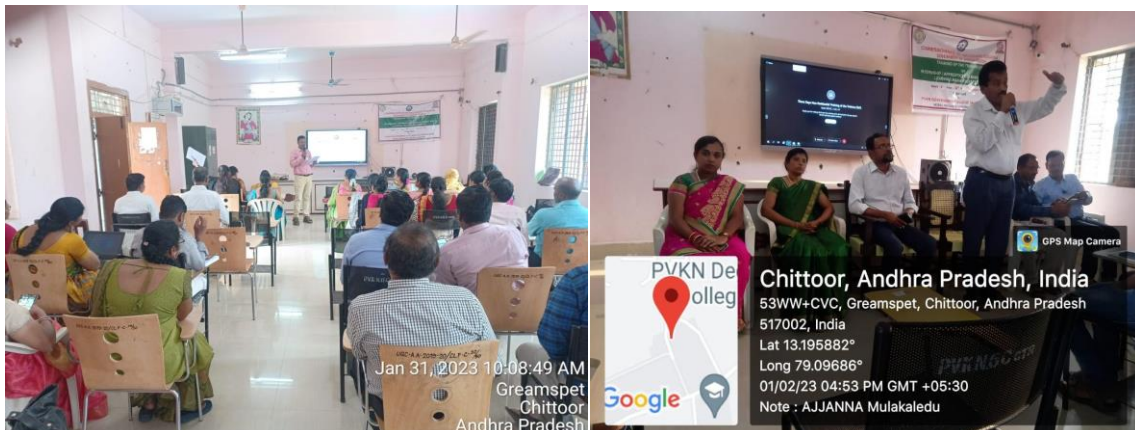

6. Guest Lecture on 25-01-2023

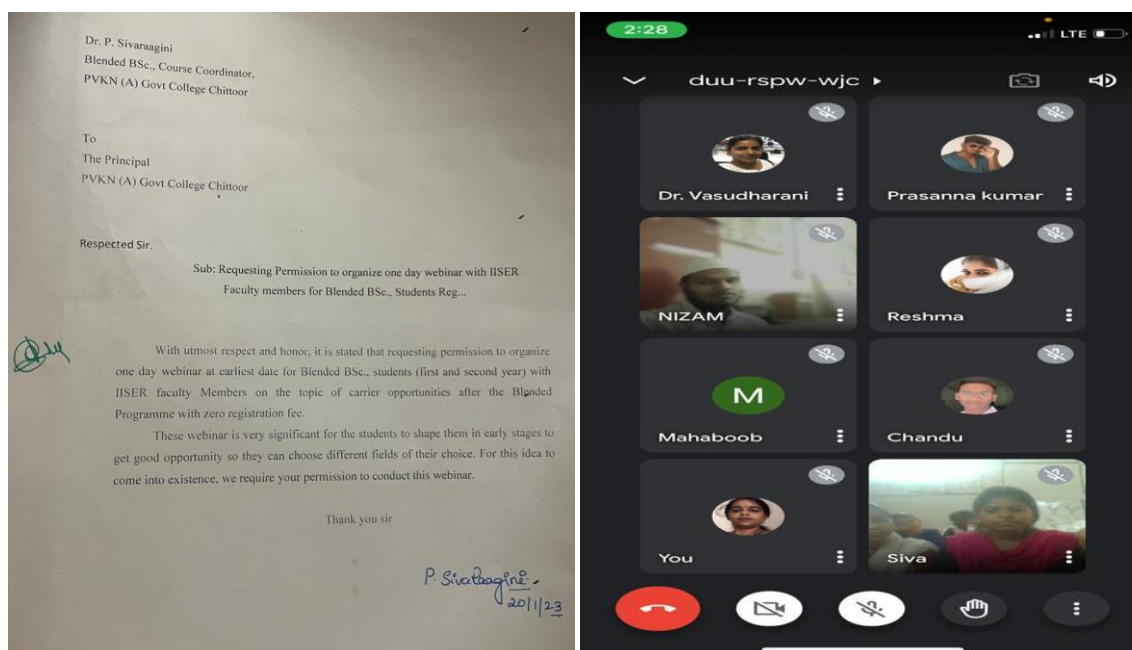

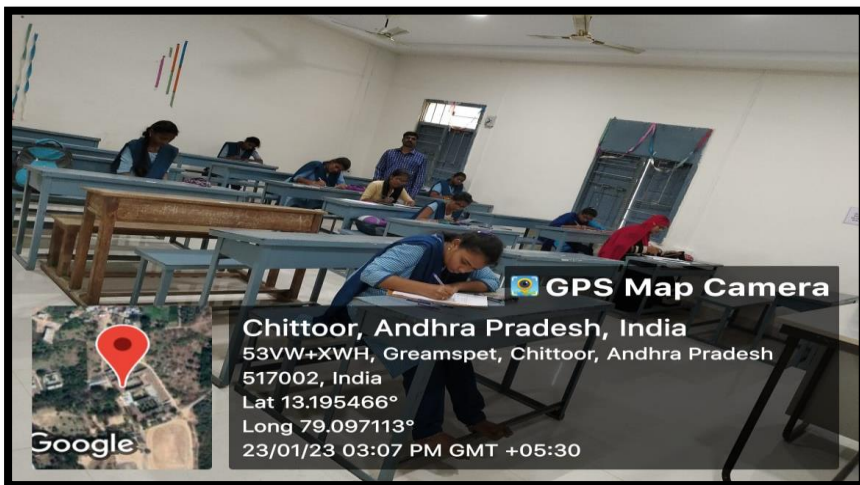


8. National Voters Day Celebration Celebrated On 25th January 2023

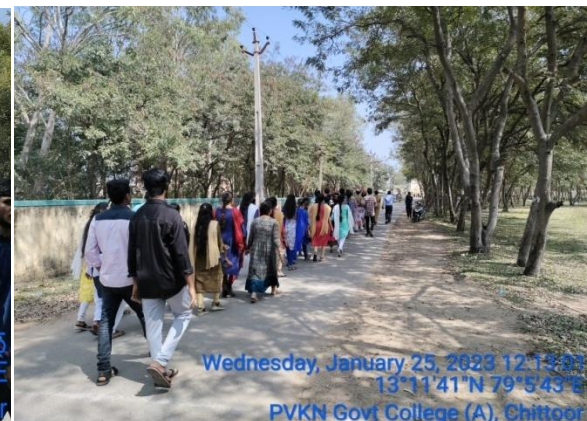
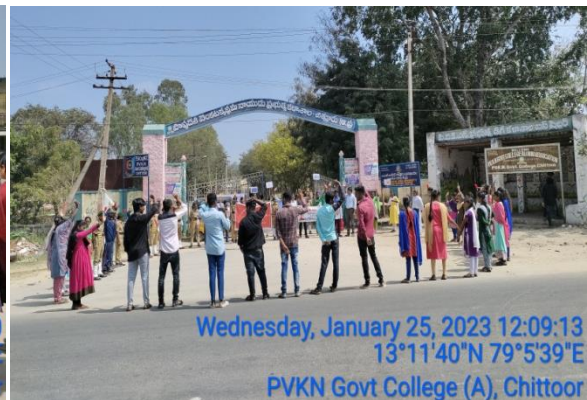


11. NATIONAL VOTERS' DAY (25-01-2023)

PowerPoint Presentation on the Origin, Structure, Medical applications and Harmful effects of the consumption of drugs like Cocaine and Heroin.

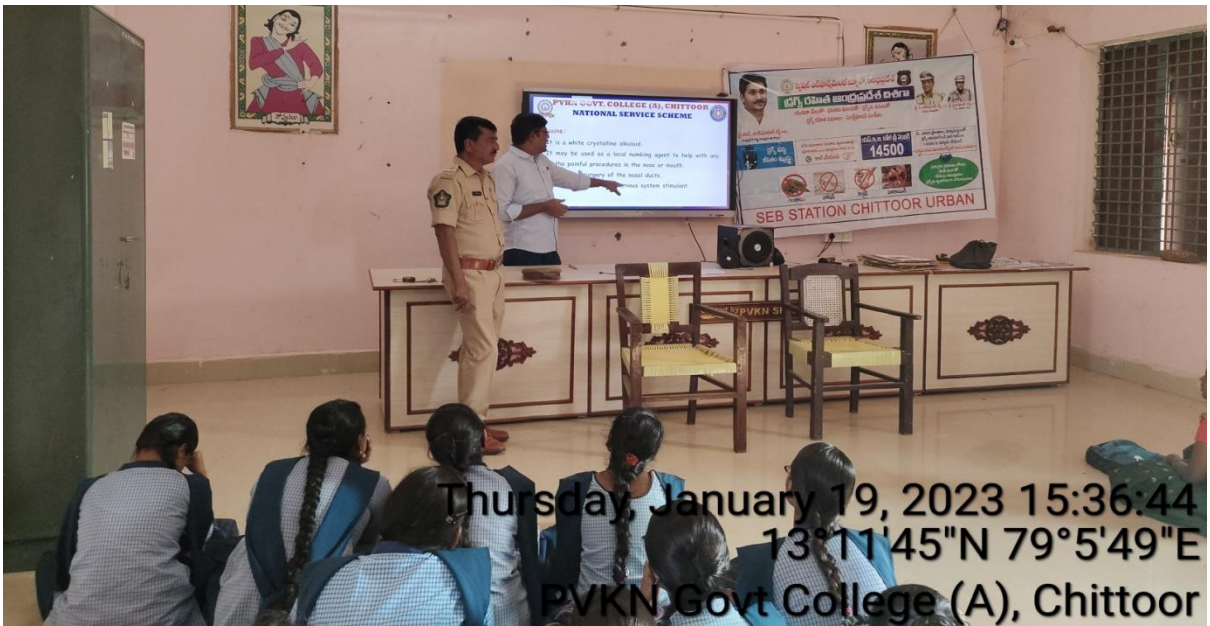
